<u>The Philippines</u> Online Training Course on Infrastructure Development for NPP Introduction

The Department of Energy (DOE) of the Philippines has set the achievement of the mandatory level of Phase 2 of the IAEA Infrastructure Development Items (19 items) as its main mission. In response to the DOE's request for assistance to achieve this goal, we provided 12 training courses on infrastructure development for NPP introduction last year and 5 courses this year(2022). In this fiscal year, the training was provided to total of 393 participants from the Department of Energy (DOE) and the Nuclear Energy Program Inter-Agency Committee (NEP-IAC), which is the nerve center of the nuclear power program planning process.
