

Seminar for Vietnam Agency for Radiation and Nuclear Safety (VARANS)

JICC held the 4th JICC-Vietnam Agency for Radiation and Nuclear Safety (VARANS) Seminar in Hanoi, Vietnam, in cooperation with International Nuclear Energy Development of Japan Co., Ltd. (JINED).

【Background/Objectives】 ;

The Ninh Thuan NPP project in Vietnam has been suspended. However, at the request of the Vietnamese side, which considers human resource development important for the restart of the nuclear power program, JICC has continued to cooperate with Vietnam. This time, we held a seminar as part of our human resource development program for nuclear regulation.

【Results】 ;

- ① After a period of holding the seminar online due to the Covid-19, the seminar was welcomed to be held locally in Vietnam for the first time in three years. The seminar was attended not only by VARANS but also by experts from the Vietnam Atomic Energy Institute (VINATOM) and other organizations, who were interested in the presentation on radiation monitoring.
- ② On the occasion of their visit to Hanoi, JICC and JINED also paid courtesy calls to Vietnam's nuclear-related organizations, including the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MOIT), the Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST), the Central Economic Commission of Vietnam, the National Assembly's Committee on Science, Technology and Environment, Technology and Environment, the Vietnam Electricity (EVN), and the Vietnam Atomic Energy Institute (VINATOM), to exchange views with each organization.
