Nuclear Energy Seminar in Prague, Czech Republic

On September 27, 2024, JICC organized a seminar in Prague, Czech Republic, jointly with the Czech Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT) in a MoIT's conference room.

<Background/Objectives>

The Prague on-site seminar was held at the request of the MoIT as a part of our international cooperation project to improve the infrastructure for nuclear power generation in the Czech Republic.

<Results>

- (1) The seminar in Prague jointly organized by JICC and the MoIT was held on the topic of radioactive waste management/high-level waste geological disposal. Czech nuclear key persons gathered by the MoIT, approximately 40 experts, were in attendance at a conference room in MoIT.
- (2) H.E. Mr. Kensuke Nagaoka, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, Embassy of Japan in the Czech Republic gave the opening remarks, followed by a lecture from the Agency for Natural Resources and Energy, METI. Experts from Japan Nuclear Fuel Limited (JNFL), Nuclear Waste Management Organization of Japan (NUMO), and Hitachi GE also participated from Japan. Following the presentations by experts from both countries, a positive exchange of opinions took place.
