

JICC Invited the Philippines Delegation to Japan

JICC invited the Philippines Delegation (Officials from Department Energy and Power companies who execute pre-study on nuclear power plant deployment.) from 6 to 11 October, 2024.

【Background/Objectives】 ;

The Philippines signed a Memorandum of Understanding (123 Agreement) on the Peaceful Use of Nuclear Energy with the United States in November 2023, and a joint statement after the Japan-US-Philippines Summit in April 2024 was also announced on strengthening cooperation in the field of clean energy, including civilian nuclear power. Considering such background, JICC invited the Philippines Delegation to Japan to deepen their understanding on current situation of nuclear power and trend in nuclear industries in Japan.

【Results】 ;

① The Delegation visited Japan Atomic Power Company (JAPC) Tokai Power Station Unit 2 under preparation work for restart & Tokai Training Center and TEPCO Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station under execution of decommissioning and recovery process from the Great East Japan Earthquake.

② The Delegation paid a courtesy meeting to Office for International Nuclear Energy Cooperation Agency of Natural Resources and Energy METI, and had meeting with Japan Bank for International Corporation, JAPC HQ, IHI and JGC Corporation as well as shop tour of IHI Yokohama Works to deepen their understanding on nuclear industries in Japan.
