

Participation for the Philippines International Nuclear Supply Chain Forum

JICC participated as a member of Japan delegation in the 1st Philippine International Nuclear Supply Chain Forum held by the Philippine Department of Energy from Nov. 13 to 15, 2024.

【Background/Objectives】 ;

The Philippines signed a Memorandum of Understanding (123 Agreement) on the Peaceful Use of Nuclear Energy with the United States in November 2023, and a joint statement after the Japan-US-Philippines Summit in April 2024 was also announced on strengthening cooperation in the field of clean energy, including civilian nuclear power. In terms of such background, the Philippines Department of Energy requested METI to dispatch Japan Delegation for the 1st Philippine International Nuclear Supply Chain Forum. JICC participated in this forum as a member of the Japan delegation under instruction from METI.

【Results】 ;

①The Delegations from US, France, Canada, Korea, Japan and the relevant energy policy officials from ASEAN countries were invited. The Forum was positioned as an international nuclear forum to support the deployment of nuclear power plant in the Philippines with well attendance of more 100 people. The Japan Delegation introduced the current situation of nuclear power plant and nuclear industries in Japan. JICC introduced nuclear international cooperation activities.

②Individual meeting with the Philippines DOE and power companies was organized to hear their intentions and interesting on agenda of JICC seminar under planning to be held at same timing with Japan-United States-Philippines Trilateral Dialogue.
